**Exhibitors Please Notice**

- The tracking site is open to the public; cover is medium to tall and terrain is hilly.
- Make checks payable to CKHGC (Central KY Herding Group Club). All fees are payable in US Funds. Please type or print all information on AKC entry forms required for entry. Entries must include: Entry Fee. Separate check for each entry, write the dog's registration number on the check. Entry form signed by owner or representative. Certification if required. Fees: \$75 for TD, \$100 for TDX.
- Note Entry Close Date of Monday, November 23, 2009 at 6 pm and Draw Date will be Tuesday, November 24, 2009. Event Secretary will notify entrants of results of the draw within 24 hours; please be sure to include your phone number on your entry.
- Bitches in season may participate in accordance with AKC Regulations, Chapter 2, Section 8.
- The TD drawing for tacks will be 8:30 AM EST with the first track to start at 8:45 AM. The TDX drawing for tracks will be at 10:45 AM with the first track to start at 11:00 AM.
- In the event an accepted entry is absent on the day of the test, it shall be the responsibility of the event secretary to determine if any alternates are present. If so, space will be filled by such in the order they were drawn. NO entry fee will be refunded except for alternates who do not participate. Every effort will be made to refund entry fees within seven days of the test.
- Please clean up after your dog and yourself. We ask the cooperation of everyone in helping to keep the Test location as clean as possible in order to be able to hold future events at this location.

**AGREEMENT**

I (we) agree that the club holding this event has the right to refuse this entry for cause which the club shall deem sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prizes, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event-giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or event secretaries and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.

**INSTRUCTIONS**

1. (Variety) If you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in., but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquisition, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)
5. Dogs entering mixed breed classes (eligible only in standardbred Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials) should mark Breed as 'MIXED BREED.' Variety, Breeder, Sire, Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrants.

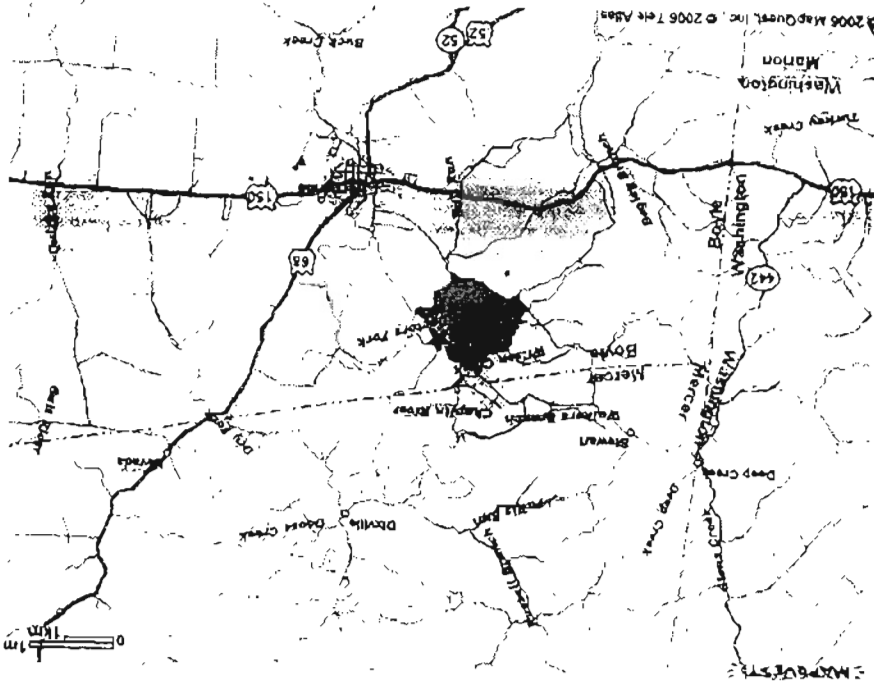
