- Entries will open at 8:00AM on Wednesday, September 14, 2011 Central Standard Time at the Trial Secretary's home. Entries received before that time will be returned.

- Make checks or money orders payable to the Central Kentucky Herding Group Club (CKHGC). All fees are payable in U.S. funds. Please type or print all information required on entry form. Entry fees are \$45.00 per trial per dog per class for sheep runs. Entry fees are \$35.00 per dog per class for duck runs.
- **For Exhibition Only** trial entries will be accepted if entry limits are not reached. FEO entry fee will be \$25.00. Scores will not be recorded and will not count toward AKC herding titles.
- Entries close at 6:00PM CST, Monday, October 31, 2011 at the Trial Secretary's home, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided in Chapter 1, Section 13 of the *AKC Herding Regulations*. When numerical limits are exceeded, additional entries will be placed on an alternates' list.
- Drawing for running order will be held at the Trial Secretary's home on Monday, October 31, 2011, at 6:00PM, CST.
- There will be no refund of entry fees for dogs that are absent, retired, removed, excused or disqualified or if because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or compete in the Trial. If a dog is absent and is replaced by an alternate, then the entry fee shall be refunded.
- Entrants on the alternates' list must check in with the Trial Secretary on the Trial grounds no later than thirty (30) minutes prior to start of trial each day. Alternates that do not have the opportunity to run shall have the entry fee refunded.
- Requests to move-up must be given to the Trial Secretary at least thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the trial.
- A dog may be entered in sheep and/or Trial class and a Test class each day. However, either the Test or Trial entry should be designated the priority entry on the entry form, should the entry limits be reached. The other entries will then be taken as alternates. Bitches in season will run last in the Test and in catalog order in the Trials.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A \$25.00 collection fee will be added to each returned check.
- No refunds will be made for duplicated entries or errors on entry blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such.
- The Central Kentucky Herding Group Club may decline **any** entries and may remove **any** dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against the Central Kentucky Herding Group Club or any official thereof.
- The Test and Trial site is in the Eastern Time Zone.
- There will be a lunch break at the judge's discretion each day.
- Many restaurants are available in Elizabethtown, at Interstate 65, Exit 94. Lunch will be available for purchase on site for \$6.00.
- Please clean up after your dog and yourself. We ask the cooperation of exhibitors in helping to keep the Trial location as clean as possible in order to be able to hold future AKC events at this facility.
- The initial handlers' meeting will be held at 7:45AM each day. Subsequent handlers' meetings will be held before each class.
- A separate entry must be made for each dog. The AKC waiver statement, included in the entry blank, must accompany each entry and must be SIGNED for the entry to be accepted. Entries without legible phone / e-mail information will be refused.
- All dogs must be held on leash or otherwise restricted except when competing. Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena. See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the *AKC Herding Regulations*.
- This is a working farm, please take care to close and latch all gates.
- Please remember to bring shade, water, chairs and raingear.
- The Central Kentucky Herding Group Club, its officers and representatives, the Trial Chair, Secretary, Committee and the owner of the Trial site assume no responsibility for loss, damage, or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors' property and their dogs and further assume no responsibility for injury to children. 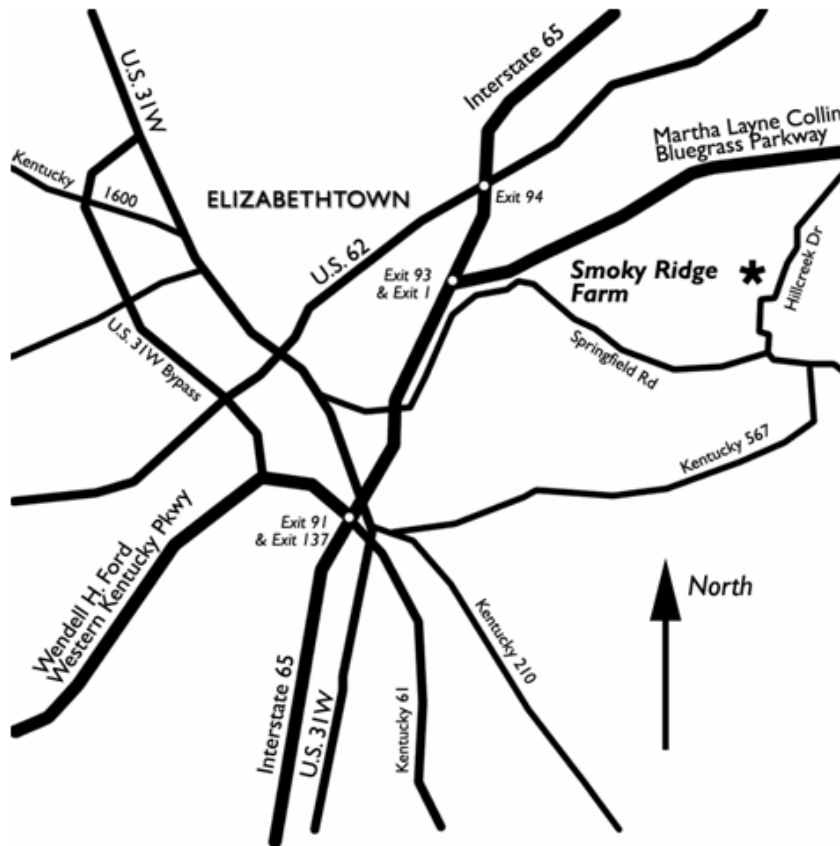

**From Louisville or North** – Take I-65 South. **From Nashville or South** – Take I-65 North. **From Lexington or East** – Take the Martha Layne Collins Bluegrass Parkway West to the end, and then follow the signs to I-65 South. **From Paducah and West** – Take the Wendell H. Ford Western Kentucky Parkway to the end, and follow directions from there.

**From all these places** – Proceed to the Elizabethtown / Hodgenville exit (#91). Follow signs as if you are going to Hodgenville until you get to the first red light, which is U.S. Route 31W (this is also the end of the WK Parkway). Turn left on U.S. 31W and proceed to the next light and turn right on Kentucky 210. Go about a block and then turn left onto Kentucky 567 (Valley Creek Road). Go straight through the four-way stop sign and continue on about four miles to the Valley Creek Baptist Church, turn left at the church onto Springfield Road - Note the cute little lamb in the stained glass window. Continue about ½ mile to the first street on the right, which is Hillcreek Drive. Hillcreek Drive is a winding country road, so be very careful of blind curves. Smoky Ridge Farm is on your left, with the name “Miller” on the mailbox and a sign with a sheep upon it. There is a long red barn and you will see the course from the road. If you get to the dead end, you’ve gone too far.

## AGREEMENT

I (we) acknowledge that the "Rules applying to Registration and dog shows" and the "Rules for Herding Tests & Trials" have been made available to me (us), and that I (we) agree that the club holding this Herding Test or Trial has the right to refuse this entry for cause, which the club shall deem to be sufficient. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and the holding of the Herding Test or Trial and of the opportunity to have the dog tested or judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold this club, its members, directors, governors, officers, agents, superintendents or show secretary and the owner or lessor of the premises and any employees of the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or upon the Herding Test or Trial premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim for damage or injury to the dog, whether such loss, disappearance, theft, damage or injury, be caused by the negligence of the club or any of the parties aforementioned, or by the negligence of any other person, or any other causes.
